A Modern Apprenticeship (MA) is designed to equip individuals with practical skills and industry-specific knowledge, leading to recognised qualifications. MAs get the skills they need through a combination of on the job training and college study to achieve their industry recognised qualification. They can look forward to lots of hands-on practical training and the support of both their employer and the College.

Three Steps to Become a Modern Apprentice

STEP 1 CHOOSE AN INDUSTRY

The apprentice should choose an industry that aligns with their interests and career ambitions. This then reflects the Framework used to assess the apprenticeship.

STEP 2 IDENTIFY AN EMPLOYER

Find an employer who will employ you & support your apprenticeship.

STEP 3 REGISTER INTEREST

The employer should contact Forth Valley College in order to arrange an Apprenticeship Officer to manage your apprenticeship.



Modern Apprentices Frameworks

Frameworks are used to assess apprenticeships - they define the competence level and timescales that the apprenticeship must be delivered within.

They are developed by relevant industry bodies and approved by the **Scottish Modern Apprenticeship Group (MAG)**.

The specific framework of a modern apprentice's training and qualifications is determined by the industry they are working in.
